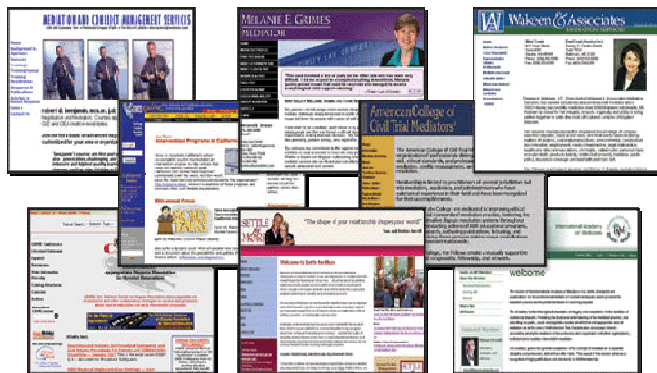

End of Free Web?

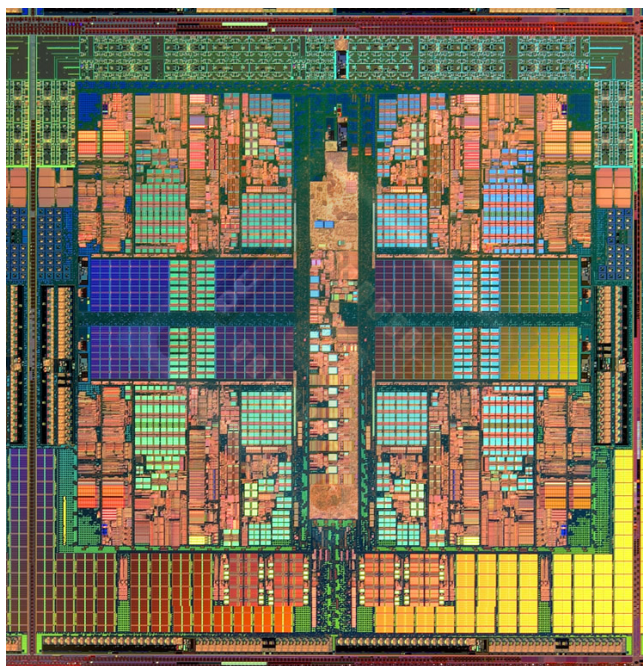


With the newspapers gradually moving to subscription only to view their content online, then yes it is the end of everything free on the web. However it is a gradual thing and prices are very low.
